Broomhall House, home of the Earls of Elgin, contains treasures relating to several British colonial adventures overseas in the nineteenth century.

In this visit, we will be viewing a collection of artefacts relating to one such adventure: the periods in which the 8th and 9th Earls of Elgin acted as Viceroy of India. This collection includes diplomatic gifts, religious and festival ephemera, photographs, and personal letters from Queen Victoria. Our visit will be guided by Charles Bruce, patron of the Scottish Centre of Tagore Studies, and Chairman of the Kolkata Scottish Heritage Trust.
